


Notifications in late January (4 winners)




School Year: Deadlines are the first Monday of each quarter. Up to 10 awards a quarter






Academic progress evaluated annually Stipend paid in 9 monthly installments per year May need to defer other sources of funding (Hertz will coordinate with other funding source to do so)




Encourage underrepresented groups to apply

Application opens September 3rd, notifications in April (~10% receive awards)




May not have held a dissertation-writing fellowship the prior year. No other single awards of larger value permitted concurrently. Awards of lesser amounts must be approved by the AAUW
